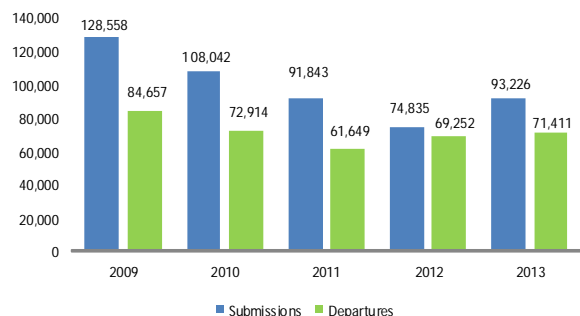

### RESETTLEMENT IN 2013

Resettlement took place from 80 countries of asylum to 25 countries of resettlement (including special programmes), involving refugees from 69 countries of origin.

93,226 submissions for resettlement (24.6% increase from 2012)

71,411 departures for resettlement (3.1% increase from 2012)

Global average acceptance rate: 94.4%

12.1% of submissions were submitted under the women and girls at risk category

### PROJECTED GLOBAL RESETTLEMENT NEEDS AND UNHCR'S SUBMISSION TARGETS 2014

Global resettlement needs are an estimated 94,113, in addition to the anticipated increase in resettlement needs of 30,000 Syrian refugees generated by the massive outflow of refugees from the Syrian Arab Republic.

UNHCR plans to submit 88,986 refugees for resettlement in 2014 (target).

### RESPONSE TO THE SYRIA EMERGENCY

UNHCR is proposing that countries admit up to 30,000 Syrian refugees on resettlement, humanitarian admission or other programmes by the end of 2014, with a focus on protecting the most vulnerable.

### RESETTLEMENT COUNTRIES WITH REGULAR PROGRAMMES

### EMERGENCY TRANSIT FACILITIES (ETFs)

ETFs in the Philippines, Romania and Slovakia together provide over 400 places from where refugees can continue the resettlement process.
