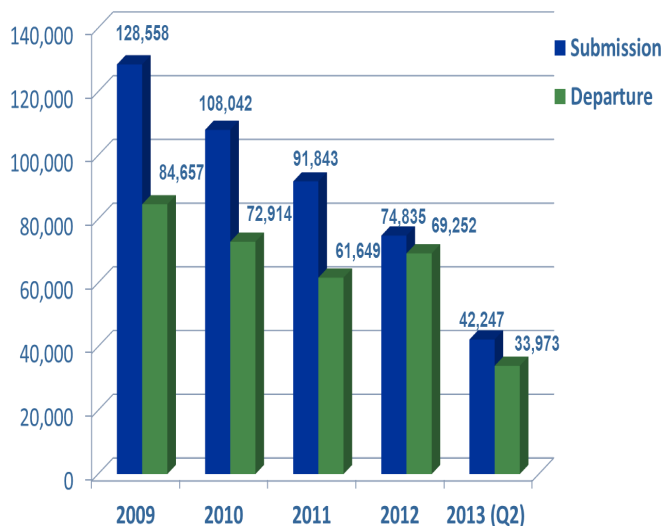

RESETTLEMENT IN 2012

- Resettlement took place from 80 countries of asylum to 26 countries of resettlement (including special programmes), involving refugees from 79 countries of origin
- 74,835 submissions for resettlement (18% decrease from 2011)
- 69,252 departures for resettlement (12% increase from 2011)
- Global average acceptance rate: 88.4%
- More than 11% of submissions under women and girls at risk category

AND UNHCR'S SUBMISSION TARGETS 2014

- Global resettlement needs are an estimated 690,915, in addition to the anticipated increase in resettlement needs generated by the massive outflow of refugees from the Syrian Arab Republic
- UNHCR plans to submit 94,113 refugees for resettlement in 2014 (target)

RESPONSE TO THE SYRIA EMERGENCY

- UNHCR advocates for resettlement as well as humanitarian admission programmes for vulnerable refugees from Syria who have compelling protection needs

RESETTLEMENT COUNTRIES WITH REGULAR PROGRAMMES

- Argentina, Australia, Belgium, Brazil, Bulgaria (starting 2014), Canada, Chile, Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Japan (pilot), Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Portugal, Romania, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, United Kingdom, Uruguay, United States of America
